- 'Serpent' = Nachash הנחש' 'The Shining One'
- Adam made in the image of (like) God Gen 1:26
- Satan (Lucifer) was the 'anointed Cherub' Ezek 28:14
- Satan's sin was pride 1 Tim 3:6
- Satan wanted to be 'like God' Isaiah 14:14

The Vendetta

¹Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

- 'Subtle' = Aruwm ערום 'wise, full of wisdom, prudent'
- Satan goes for the weak part of our flesh
- Satan exploits a lack of understanding of God's Word
- Satan's principle attack is to make us doubt God's Word
- Satan's calls into question God's character

Let a man question the inspiration of the Scríptures and a curíous, even monstrous, inversion takes place: thereafter he judges the Word instead of letting the Word judge him; he determines what the Word should teach instead of permitting it to determine what he should believe; he edits, amends, strikes out, adds at his pleasure; but always he sits above the Word and makes it amenable to him instead of kneeling before God and becoming amenable to the Word.
